- 1. Worry/Anxiety** – Matt. 6:25-34, Luke 12:22-32, Phil. 4:6-8, 1 Pet. 5:6-7, Psalm 55:22
- 2. Doubt/Lack of Faith** – Heb. 11:6, James 1:6-8, Matt. 14:31, Rom. 10:17
- 3. Unrepented Sin** – Heb. 12:1-2, 1 John 1:9, Gal. 5:16-26, 2 Tim. 3:1-5
- 4. Anger/Bitterness** – Heb. 12:14-15, Eph. 4:26-27, 31-32
- 5. Unforgiveness** – Mark 11:25-26, Matt. 6:14-15, Col. 3:12-13, 2 Cor. 2:10-11, Matt. 18:21-22
- 6. Discouragement/Hopelessness** – Gal. 6:9, 2 Cor. 3:17-18 – 4:1, Heb. 6:17-20, Matt. 11:28-30
- 7. Busyness** – Luke 10:38-42, Prov. 16:3, Matt. 6:33
- 8. Fear** – 2 Tim. 1:7, 1 John 4:18, Isaiah 41:10, 13, Psalm 23:4, 34:4, John 14:1, 27, Psalm 27!
